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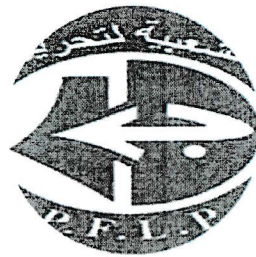

The foreign funding of the PFLP through the network of "civil society" organizations

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May 2, 2021

Background





The Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine terror organization (PFLP)



- The PFLP is one of the Palestinian opposition organizations who forcefully oppose the political process with Israel, particularly the Oslo Accords. The organization stands out for its uncompromising attitude towards Israel, advocates for the continuation of 'armed struggle', and aspires for the establishment of a secular Palestinian state throughout the territory of Palestine instead of the State of Israel
- The organization was established in December 1967 by George Habash. During the 1970s, the PFLP was prominent as the organization that initiated and led airplane hijacking attacks, and in 1972, its operatives, assisted by Japanese guerillas (Kozo Okamoto), carried out a terrorist attack at Israel's airport in which 22 people were killed.
- The PFLP is considered the second most important organization after the PLO. Due to the organization's limited scope, its operatives aspired to stand out through targeted terrorist activities and by influencing public opinion against Israel (such as hijacking passenger planes, attacking Israelis).
- In 2001, Ahmad Sa'adat, a senior figure in the organization, was appointed as head of the PFLP. Sa'adat, a Ramallah resident, has been involved in severe terrorist activities against Israel, and is now serving his sentence in an Israeli prison after having been convicted for his role in the murder of Israeli Tourism Minister Rehavam Ze'evi ("Ghandi") RIP, which was carried out by PFLP operatives (17 October 2001).

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The PFLP - Continued

- During the Second Intifada (beginning September 2000), PFLP operatives 'uprose' by carrying out a series of car bombing attacks in Israel, as well as shooting and IED attacks in the West Bank and mortar shell fire in the Gaza Strip. As stated, the organization's operatives even murdered Minister Rehavam Ze'evi in a hotel in Jerusalem. During this period, there was close cooperation between PFLP operatives and the operatives of other Palestinian terrorist organizations for the purposes of carrying out terrorist attacks against Israel.
- From 2013 onwards, following the Shalit deal and release of the organization's operatives into the field, a significant turnaround was identified in the PFLP – the radical stream dominated the organization and began to promote a strength-building and reorganization process, including the building of military infrastructures. In addition, PFLP operatives train in Lebanon under the patronage of Hezbollah. The close connections and cooperation between the PFLP and Hezbollah and Iran also continue.
- In 2014, the military wing of the PFLP was responsible for a number of terrorist activities, the most notable of which was the massacre that was carried out at a synagogue in Jerusalem (2014) in which 5 worshippers and a police officer were murdered. Furthermore, the PFLP's military wing took part in the rounds of fighting against Israel in Gaza by firing rockets into Israel.
- From 2017 until today – the organization has been renewing its military activities, which peaked with the terrorist attack in Ein Bubin on 23/08/2019, which caused the death of Rina Shnerb R.I.P. Following the attack, towards the end of 2019, an extensive PFLP military infrastructure was discovered in the West Bank, and many weapons were seized.

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The PFLP's "civil society" institutions



- The PFLP established a network of cover institutions in the West Bank that seemingly operate under the guise of civilian-humanitarian purposes.
- These institutions, dubbed "civil society" organizations, present themselves as working towards humanitarian goals, however act under PFLP leadership and in accordance with the organization's directives, as a cover for promoting the PFLP's activities and funding.
- The PFLP's network of institutions constitutes a critical role in the terrorist organization's existence, particularly in strengthening and building power.

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The information that led to an investigation



- In recent years, there has been much intelligence about the fact that PFLP institutions in the West Bank receive donations from Europe in exceptional amounts of millions of euros.
- The declared purpose of these donations was the promotion of humanitarian projects, however the information pointed to the fact that part of these donations were transferred to the terrorist organization itself.
- Among the most prominent PFLP institutions that received donations in exceptional amounts from Europe was the Health Work Committee (HWC)
- To investigate the scope of these activities, beginning in March 2021, four suspects who have served or currently serve in key roles in the institution have been arrested for questioning. The suspects, PFLP operatives who have engaged in the financial field or in the institution's external relations, were arrested for questioning on suspicion of committing terrorist financing and money laundering offenses.

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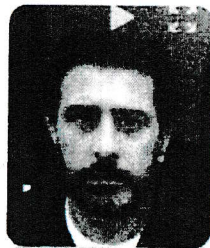


Health Work Committee – Key Suspects



Said Abedat

Born in 1975, Ramallah resident, PFLP operative, former accountant for the HWC, dismissed from his role in 2019 on the grounds that he embezzled funds.



Taisir Abu-Sharbac

Born in 1974, Ramallah resident, PFLP operative, HWC's current senior accountant



Ahwani Rashmowi

Born in 1958, Beit Sahour resident, has dual citizenship (Palestinian Authority & Spain), PFLP operative, has worked at the HWC for many years, responsible for fundraising donations from abroad for the HWC.



Amru Hamudeh

Born in 1975, Al-Bireh resident, PFLP operative, former manager of the HWC's purchasing department, dismissed from his role in 2019 on the grounds that he embezzled funds.

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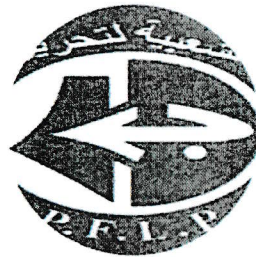
Health Work Committee – Key Suspects



The suspects were arrested based on solid information that had been collected and analyzed. Their version of the events was carefully and thoroughly examined both by investigators, intelligence analysts and by financial experts, and found to be consistent and accurate with the different type of evidence and early information collected.

The four suspects are expected to be indicted with terror financing offences and other activities related to the PFLP, within a few days.

The Investigation's Key findings



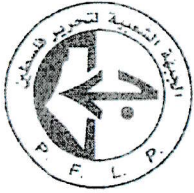
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The PFLP's network of institutions are incorporated into the PFLP's hierarchy, constitute an inseparable part of the terrorist organization, and are essential to its growth.

From Said Abidat's police protocol, 7.4.21, lines 219 – 221 (slide 28):

"... The institutions affiliated with the PFLP are interconnected and constitute a lifeline for the organization from an economic and organizational standpoint, that is, money laundering and funding of the PFLP's activities..."

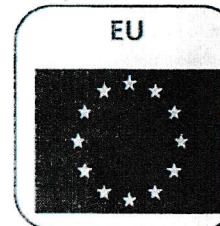
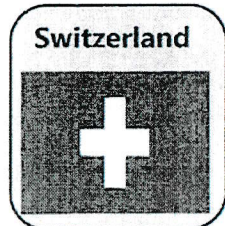
"... The PFLP controls a number of different institutions in the West Bank, and the organization is built in a hierarchical manner. At the head of the organization are senior PFLP operatives, who decide on the activities and goals of the institutions. Today, at the head of the PFLP is Halda Jarar, who I mentioned in my previous police protocol, and the activists under her are: Lajan Al Amal Al Sahi (HWC)... Lajnat Al Marah (UPWC)... Bisan Center - ... Addameer Institution - ... Lajnat Al Amal Al Zara'ai (UAWC)... Al Bisan Company - ...

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The PFLP institutions' funding, in the scope of millions of euros, was received in recent years primarily from the EU and governmental assistance organizations in Europe.

The state contributions were transferred to the HWC directly, through NGOs, or through countries' shared assistance mechanisms.

The findings of the investigation reveal that part of the European funding has been diverted to the PFLP through fraud, misrepresentation, counterfeit, theft, procurement, fictitious projects, and more.

This mechanism was operated by the PFLP and designed to divert donation funds of considerable scale to the PFLP and to activities against Israel.

From Said Abedat's police protocol, 7.4.21, lines 31 – 39 (slide 41):

"... And I carried out the financial affairs at Lajan (committee) so they were transferred to the PFLP's organizational activities, I know this because I saw the invoices and receipts that were used by the PFLP's activities... I worked in a variety of methods to fund PFLP activities through Lajan Al Amal Al Sahi (HWC), and we financed PFLP activities such as activities for universities, funding for the PFLP's sick and injured, funding for families of PFLP shahids (martyrs) and prisoners..."

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The European funding that was diverted to the PFLP served, among other things, to finance militant terrorist activities.

From Said Abadat's police protocol, 08.04.21, lines 40 – 41 (slide 30):

"... After the arrival of the finances to the central committee (of the PFLP), this committee decides how and in what manner to divide the funding between the militant and the organizational activities..."

Note that Walid Hanatshe - the chairman of the HWC - directly funded the military squad that carried out the terrorist attack in Ein Bovin in August 2019.

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The findings of the investigation highlight the absence of effective supervisory and inspection mechanisms with regard to the use of donations from Europe.

Few of the Agencies and NGOs' officials were even aware that the donations were intended for a terrorist organization.

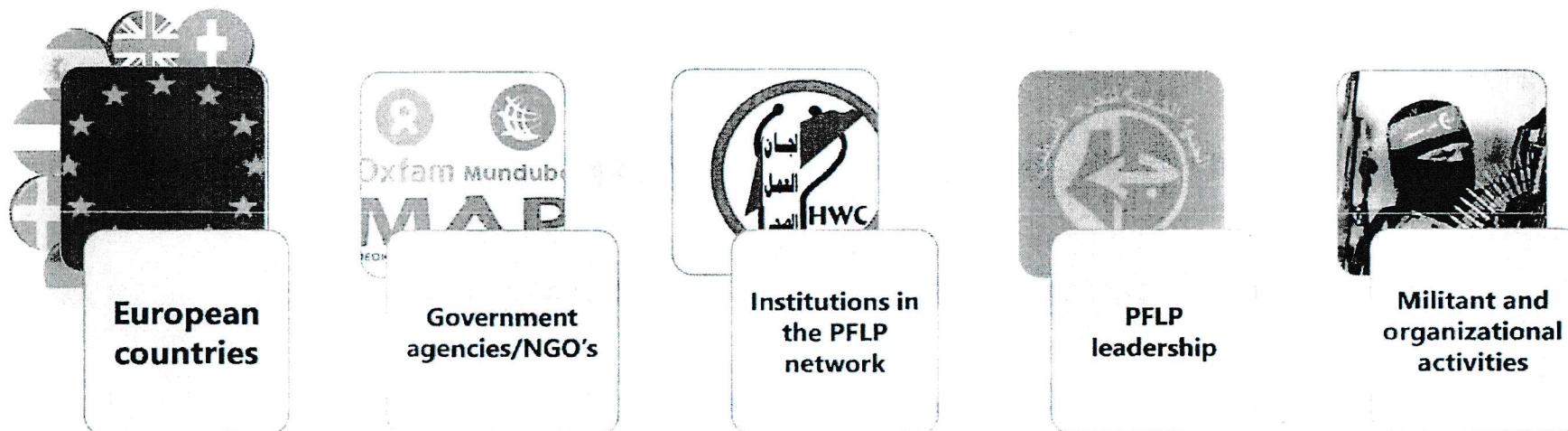

Comment: Hemudeh is referring to 'Mundubat', an NGO that operates on behalf of the Spanish (Basque) government

Summary:

The Financial path - from Europe to the PFLP's organizational and militant activities



The PFLP's network of "civil society" institutions has used a wide variety of fraud and forgery methods with the goal of diverting donations in the scope of millions of euros, which were donated by European countries for humanitarian operations, to the needs of the PFLP's terrorist organizational and militant activities.

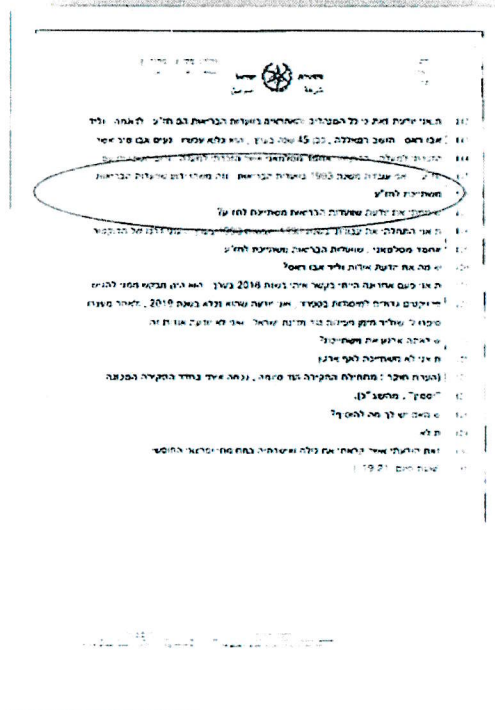

"... Q: To what organization does the Health Work Committee belong?

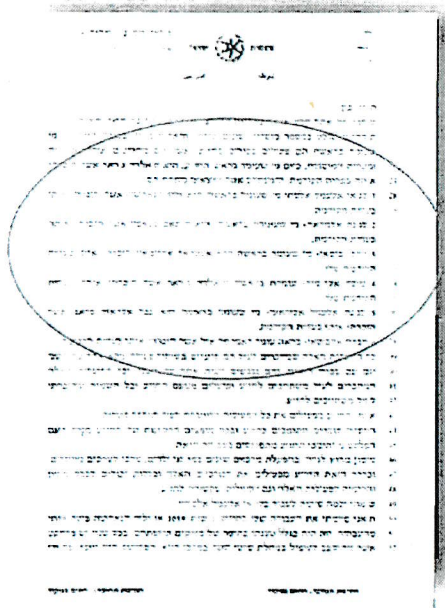
A: The PFLP

Q: How do you know that the Health Work Committee is associated with the PFLP?

A: I know this because all of the managers in charge at the Health Work Committee are PFLP, for example, Walid Abu Ras, a resident of Ramallah, about 45 years old, he is imprisoned now, Naim Abu Tir who I mentioned above, the doctor Ahmad Muslemani who I mentioned above, and most of the employees are PFLP, and I've been working for the Health Work Committee since 1993, and it's something known, that the Health Work Committee affiliates to the PFLP..."

Today, at the head of the PFLP is Halda Jarar, who I mentioned in my previous police protocol, and the activists under her are:

Lajan Al Amal Al Sahi (Health Work Committee, HWC) headed by Walid Hanatsha who I mentioned in my earlier police protocol.

Lajant Al Marah (Union of Palestinian Women's Committees UPWC) headed by Ha'tam Sa'afin who I mentioned in my earlier police protocol.

Bisan Center headed by A'atraf Al Rimo'i, I mentioned him in my earlier police protocol.

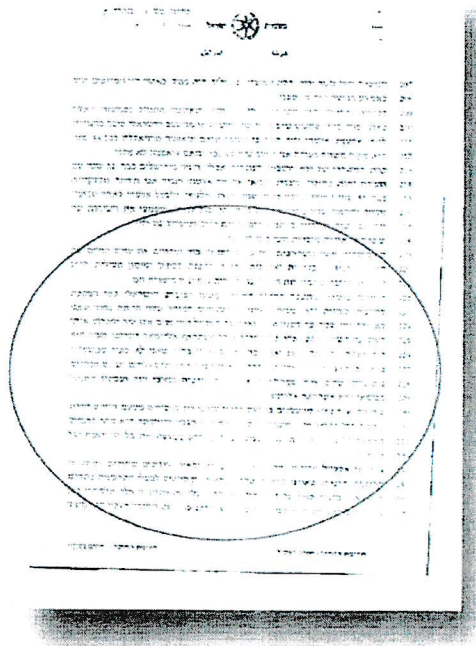

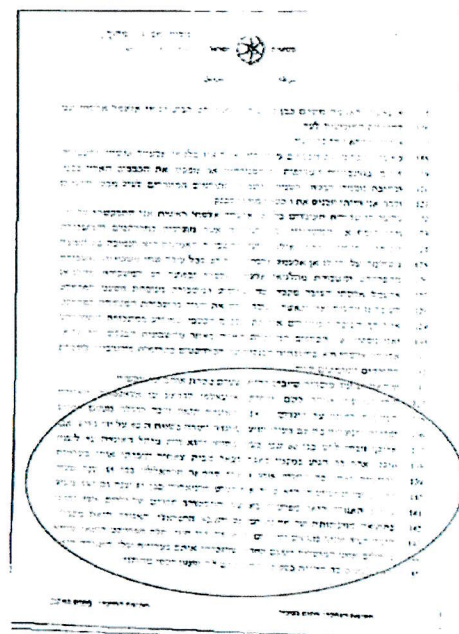
"... And most of the employees at these institutions are PFLP operatives, and the institutions are:

4. Lajan Al Amal Al Sahi (Health Work Committee, HWC)
5. Lajnat Al Marah (Union of Palestinian Women's Committees UPWC)

... All of these institutions are managed by senior PFLP operatives, and an example of this is Haldah Al-Jarar who I mentioned above, and Bashir Al Hariri and Zacharia Al Nachas who I mentioned above, and among these institutions there is cooperation between PFLP operatives in order to carry out organizational activities for the PFLP, shared projects for the PFLP, and recruitment of staff for these institutions..."

From Said Abedat's police protocol, 8.4.21, lines 134 – 145:

"... There is another association called Al-Haraqi Al-A'lami LiDfa'a an Al-Atfal (Defense for Children International) DCI. This association works on behalf of the PFLP and most of its employees are PFLP operatives...

This association receives direct annual funding from Dutch bodies... And this association is part of the 'Canaan' project, which is managed by the institutions, on behalf of the PFLP, that I mentioned in my earlier police protocol. This association does not carry out money laundering because it always has the funding from Holland..."

Comment: Amru Hamudeh, in his testimony from 6.4.21, also indicating the affiliation of DCI-P to the PFLP.

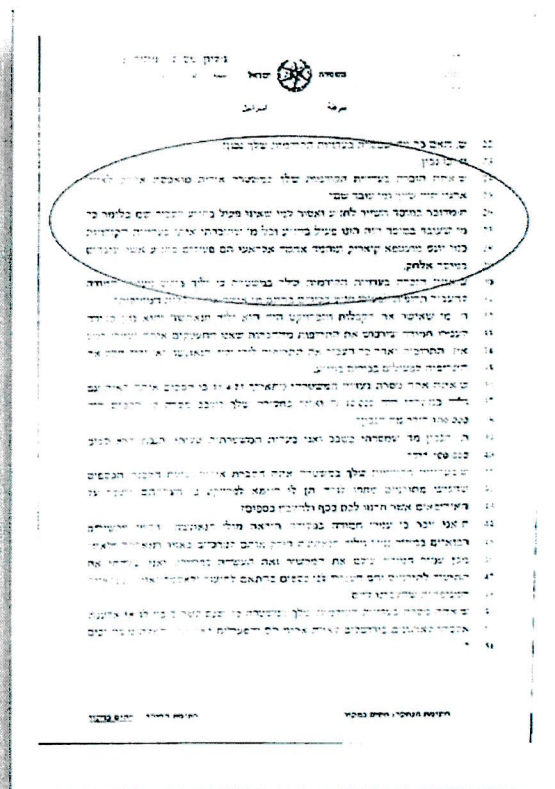

From Said Abedat's police protocol, 12.4.21, lines 24 – 29

"... You mentioned in your earlier testimonies to the police the Al-Haq institution, to which organization does it affiliate and who works there?

This is an institution that affiliates to the PFLP and anyone who is not a PFLP operative is prohibited from working there, that is, every person who works at this institution is a PFLP operative and every person that I mentioned in my previous testimonies such as Yunis Mustafa Kuarik and Mohamed Adzamer Al-Ra'ai are PFLP operatives who work at the Al-Haq institution..."

Comment: In his police protocol on 11.4.21, Abedat said (line 228) that Holland funds the Al-Haq institution, and that Al-Hak associates with the PFLP (the links between Al-Hak and the PFLP also mentioned in the testimony of Amru Hamudeh, 6.4.21, 101-110).

Organization: Union of Agricultural Work Committees (UAWC)

From Said Abedat's police protocol, 6.4.21, lines 47 – 69

"... Q: Tell me everything you know about the Union of Agricultural Work Committees?

A-48: As far as I know, this organization affiliates to the PFLP, and it operates like the Health Work Committee by forging documents and invoices, and they have funding from a number of European bodies, I'm not familiar with these bodies, and the financial situation of the Union of Agricultural Work Committees and the employees there is excellent... They opened a big shop in Ramallah... And the person responsible for this project is Samer Arbid from Ramallah, in his 40s, and he is an accountant for the Union of Agricultural Work Committees, he is currently under arrest following the attack at Ein Bubin and is affiliates with the PFLP... My estimation is that the Bisan printing company provides printing services to this association like it provides to the Health Work Committee, and also assists them in forging invoices for submission, to then receive inflated illegal funding from the donors..."

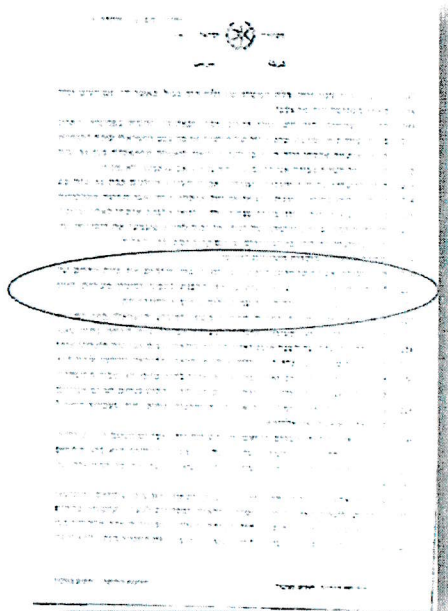

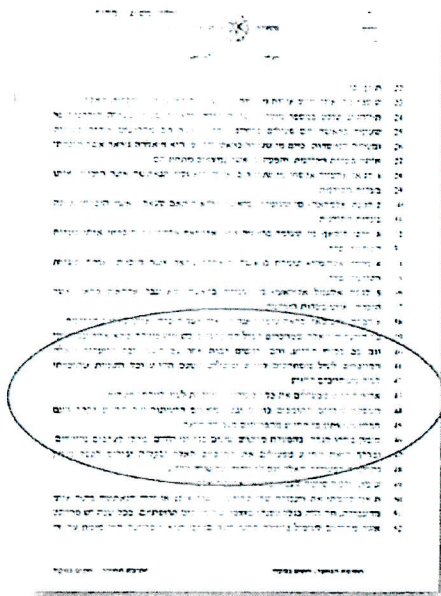


From Said Abedat's police protocol, 7.4.21, lines 219 – 221:

"... The institutions associated with the PFLP are interconnected and constitute a lifeline for the organization from an economic and organizational standpoint, that is, money laundering and funding of the PFLP's activities..."



Investigation finding: The network of institutions that the PFLP operates is essential to the organization's activities



From Amru Hamudeh's police protocol, 2.4.21, lines 39 – 48:

“... All of these committees, mentioned above, operate in full cooperation with one another and with PFLP senior operatives, and they meet one another many times. And all of these committees, mentioned above, affiliate to the PFLP and operate on behalf of the PFLP, and all the names I mentioned above are affiliated with the PFLP. The PFLP operates all the activities mentioned above for a number of goals:

- employing workers that support the PFLP, and thus PFLP ideas are disseminated among the Palestinian people and PFLP supporters make a living from this work.

- external Funding, through the operation of different centers like nurseries, a center for special needs.

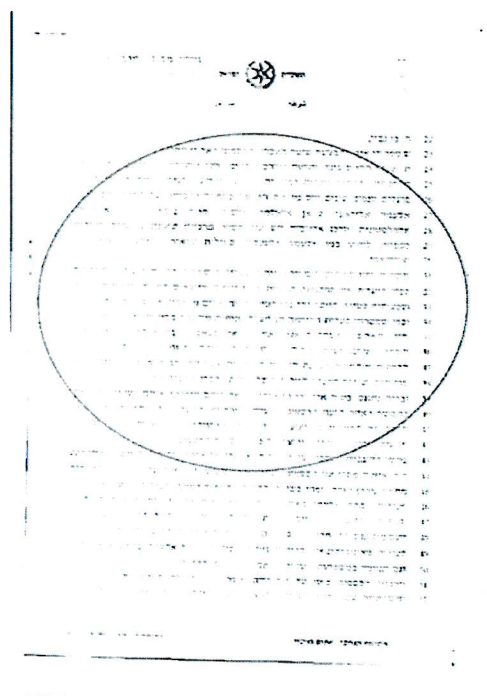
This way, the PFLP operates these centers and can easily receive funding and donations for these activities as well as for activity connected to the PFLP...”

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Investigation finding:

The institutions that the PFLP operates are subject to the PFLP's leadership. The decision of how the organization will utilize the donation funds – including for militant activities – is given to the organization's central committee

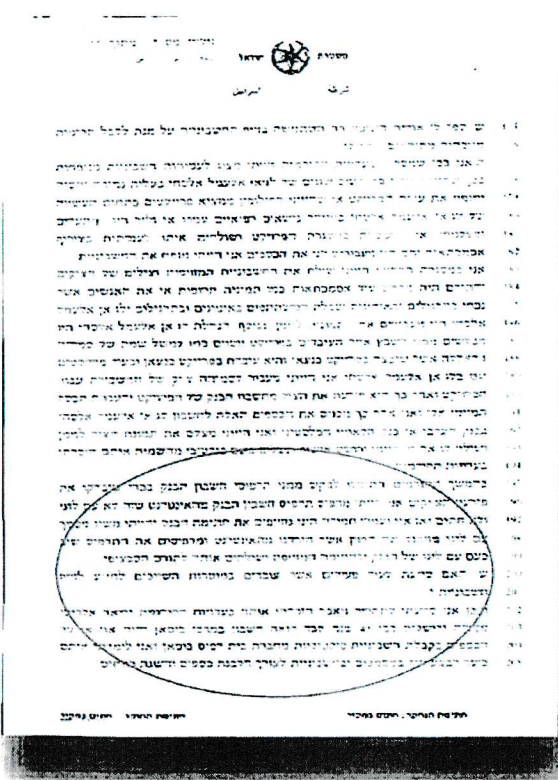


From Said Abedat's police protocol, 8.4.21, lines 24 – 41:

The PFLP works in a hierarchical manner, that is, all the PFLP institutions are subject to the central committee, under which are different committees and institutions. Under the PFLP's central committee, different branches operate, and they constitute key financial incomes for the PFLP, and they are the UAWC, the HWC, the Bisan Center, the UPWC, and Addameer, and there are a number of other centers that do not generate financial incomes for the PFLP such as Al-Amal Al-Askari (militant activities), Al-Amal Al-Jumhuri, and Al-Siasi (political). PFLP institutions are budgeted by donations and Palestinian businesses. The institutions launder money in order to increase their incomes and hide the funds that go out for external PFLP activities... There is an internal committee composed of senior PFLP operatives... and their role is to report and manage the transfer of funds, and under it is the external committee whose role is high command, and they report directly to the PFLP's central committee, and the members of the committee are... After the arrival of funds to the central committee, this committee decides how and in what manner to divide the funds between the militant and organizational activities.



Investigation finding: Institutions of the PFLP network operated in cooperation with each other



From Said Abedat's police protocol, 11.4.21, lines 200 – 205

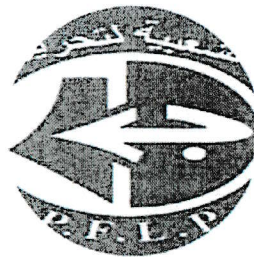
“... Eventually the donors started to request bank receipts from me in order to check the check repayments, I printed the bank receipt from the internet, which had no logo or signature, and then Amru Hamudeh and I forged the bank signature and I got a document with the bank logo from the bank, which we downloaded from the internet, and print the bank receipt again with the bank logo and a forged signature, and send it to the specific donor.

Q: Did you assist other activists who worked at institutions affiliated with the PFLP to forge invoices?

A: ... I assisted Tahrir Jaber (UPWC) and Raid Alsidi (Bisan Center)... and I taught them how to carry out forgery of documents and invoices for the purposes of money laundering and making profits...”

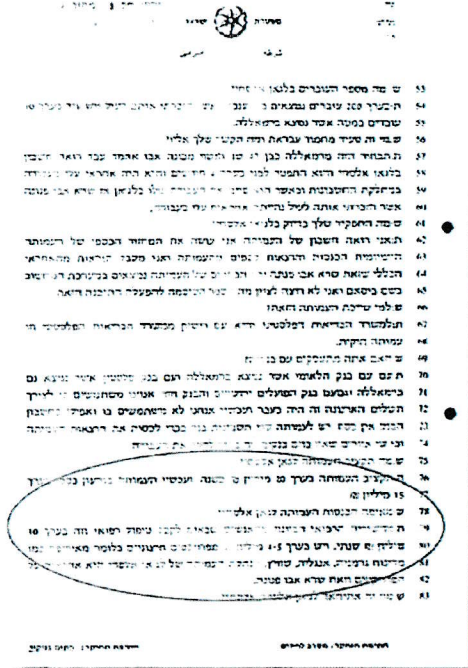

Q: Where do the HWC's incomes come from?

A: From the medical service, meaning from people
that come to receive medical care, and that's about 10
million NIS per year. And there is about 4-5 million
NIS from external projects, that is, from Europe,
countries like Germany, England, Switzerland...”

Investigation finding: Union of Agricultural Work Committees (UAWC), affiliated with the PFLP, received millions of euros as donations from European countries



From Said Abedat's police protocol, 11.4.21, lines 264 – 273

"... The Bas Baladi supermarket – is affiliated with the UAWC*... And Samer Arabid**, and he is an accountant at the UAWC as I mentioned him in my earlier police protocol. They both managed the project on behalf of the UAWC, and the profits from the supermarket go back to the institution. And about three years ago when I met Samer Arabid at his office, Hanatshe told me that the UAWC's economic situation was excellent, and that they recently received a donation of 5 million dollars from Belgium and Holland for agricultural projects. Samer also told me that the UAWC has extra funds..."

Comments:

*The Union of Agricultural Work Committees (UAWC) – during the course of the investigation, the committee was mentioned in a number of testimonies as affiliated with the PFLP's network of institutions.

**Samer Arabid – served as an accountant at the UAWC, a militant operative of the PFLP who is responsible for the terrorist attack at Ein Bubin in 2019. Rina Shnerb R.I.P was murdered in this attack.



Investigation finding: The European funding that PFLP institutions received – was used for the terrorist organization's activities

From Said Abedat's police protocol, 9.4.21, lines 24 – 58

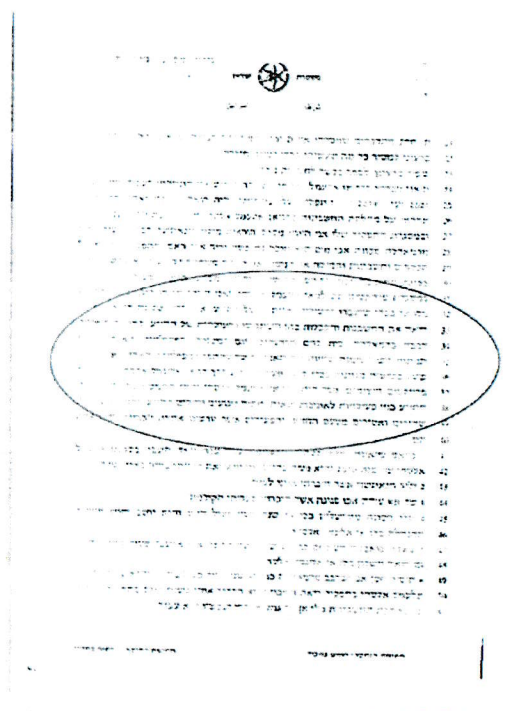
“...Q: In your previous testimonies you mentioned the Canaan project, can you please provide further details on this project?

A: It's one of the HWC's most important projects, and the first project began in 2008 until 2011, the funding for it was from the Basque government through the Mundubat PTM association, and a number of centers were partners in the project, including the UPWC, the HWC, DCI, the Bisan Center, and the Abhat Al-Ardi Center. All of these institutions I mentioned in my earlier testimonies. This project was budgeted in the amount of 250,000 euros. The second Canaan project began in 2016 until 2020, funded by the E.U through Mundubat PTM and all of the institutions that appear above participated... This project funded the following activities: 1. Salaries for employees at the centers mentioned above. 2. Courses carried out by the PFLP as part of its organizational activities... All of these courses mentioned above are managed by PFLP operatives and PFLP content is delivered during them, or Jabhat Al-Amal (the student organization of the PFLP at universities), most of the people that participate in these courses are young people identified with and affiliating to the PFLP ... Following the Canaan project, 3 youth groups were established in Jerusalem on behalf of the PFLP... The funds transferred to the bank accounts of each center, which was mentioned above, and this is considered an organizational project of the PFLP... Within the framework of this project, I supported those same methods of money laundering that I mentioned in my earlier testimonies in order to enlarge the income of the HWC...”

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Investigation finding: Funding received for projects – was transferred to the PFLP



From Said Abedat's police protocol, 7.4.21, lines 31 – 39

“... And I carried out financial affairs at the Lajan (HWC) so that they were transferred to the organizational activities of the PFLP, I know this because I reviewed the invoices and receipts that the PFLP's activities used... and also within the framework of these activities photographs were taken, and there are lists of the names of the people who participated in these activities. I worked with a variety of methods to fund PFLP activities through the HWC through the framework of external projects that came to the HWC, and we funded PFLP activities such as university activities, funding of the injured and sick for the PFLP, funding of families of shahids (martyrs) and prisoners from the PFLP...”

Investigation conclusion (3):

Part of the donations from Europe were transferred to the PFLP through a comprehensive and methodical mechanism of fraud, forgery, misrepresentation, and theft. This mechanism helped the PFLP to shift donations to the terrorist organization





Investigation finding: The Health Work Committee forged and inflated invoices

"... We are inside, every project .. buy real ... and buy something that is not real. What is not real we inflate and give it to whoever is funding it so that they will pay the total, thus closing the debts of the committees. And this is how we manage all things. And everyone knows about it ... if you buy something for 10,000 NIS, you know that 6 of it is real and 4 is in favor of closing the debts and all the documents are visible and it is not something secret and every company or entity works with you normally since each party Profit from it ...

(Note – this part is about buying vaccines)

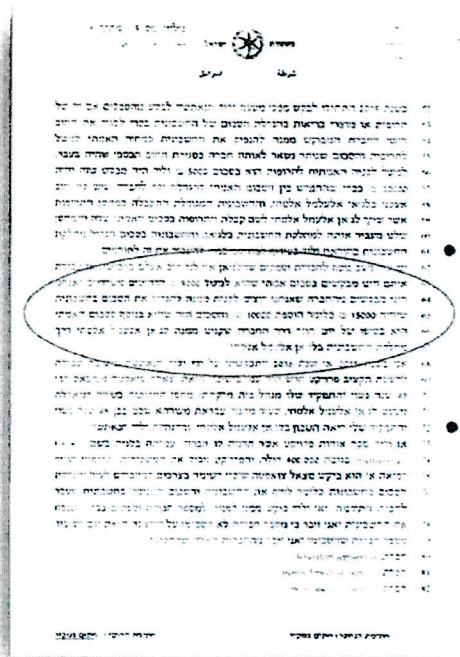
...It was already in 2018 and it's not something new and it happened twice already, we talked and they opened an axis with Dr. Nafos on the subject of the injections, we actually bought 250 but falsely they bought more, and it was written in the receipts and in the invoices and all that ... "

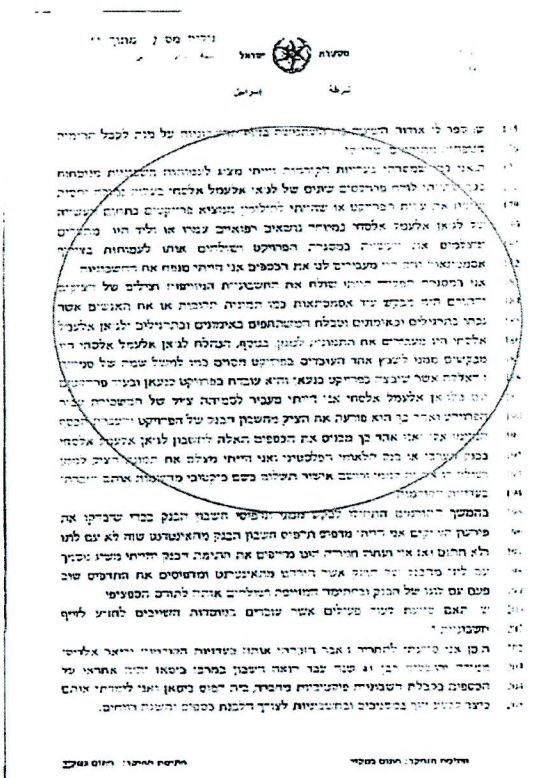
"... There is another scenario for companies and suppliers that the Lajan, we don't have any debt with them for purchasing or work, we requested a real amount like, for example, 5,000 NIS for office furniture, and we asked the company to purchase from them and enlarge the amount in the invoice so that it would be 15,000 NIS, that is, an addition of 10,000 NIS. And this amount, which is in addition to the real amount, at the end of the day returns through the company that we, the HWC, purchased from, through the billing department of the HWC..."

Lines 73 – 78:

"... Walid (Hanatshe, the manager) requested me to turn to a number of companies and suppliers in order to inflate the invoices..."



Investigation finding: The Health Work Committee forged and inflated invoices and checks



From Said Abedat's police protocol, 11.4.21, lines 177 – 199

"... I presented inflated invoices to NGOs, I took different HWC projects at a relatively low cost and inflate the cost of the project, or conversely I made up projects... Especially medical matters, Amru or Walid documented and photograph the work in the framework of the project and sent it to NGOs with references attached, and they transferred us the funds, I inflated the invoices. In the framework of my role, I sent the forged invoices and scans of the checks... And I photographed the check pictures for the donor and sent it to the donor and wrote a payment confirmation under a fictitious name from the names that I mentioned in my earlier testimonies..."

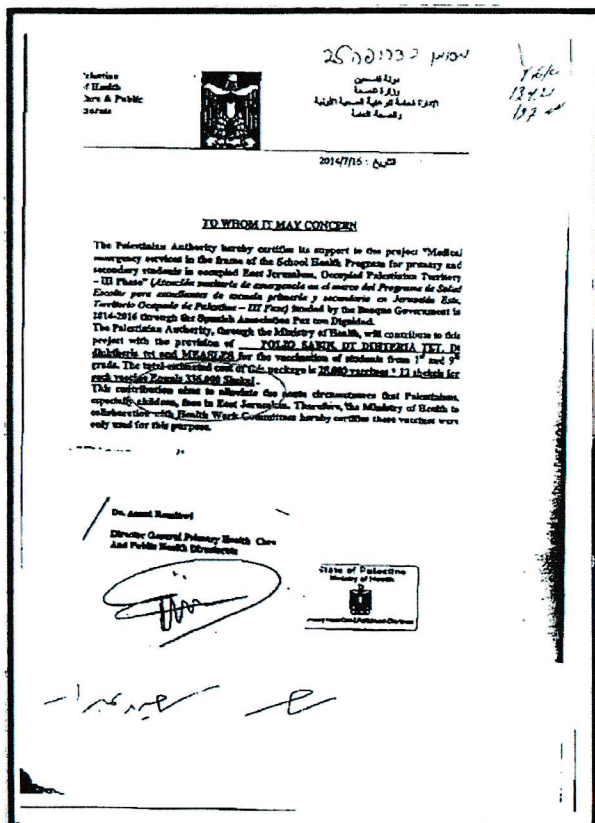
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Investigation finding: The Health Work Committee forged and inflated invoices



From Said Abedat's police protocol, 13.4.21, lines 245-254

"... Pages 197-198 are official documents written by the Palestinian Authority in connection to the vaccination of children at schools in Jerusalem, in the framework of the student health project funded by an institution of the Basque government, assisted by the Paz Degnedad institution, in the amount of 245,000 euros, and in the framework of this project the P.A must assist in the local funding of the vaccines, and the donor must fund other activities for this project, so the P.A paid 2,500 NIS, but gave the HWC a forged document, in which it was written that the amount for the vaccines was 336,000 NIS, and this is in order that the donor will approve this whole budget, which is 245,000 euros. This forgery was made because if the donor knew that the amount for the vaccines was only 2,500 NIS, they wouldn't have funded the project..."

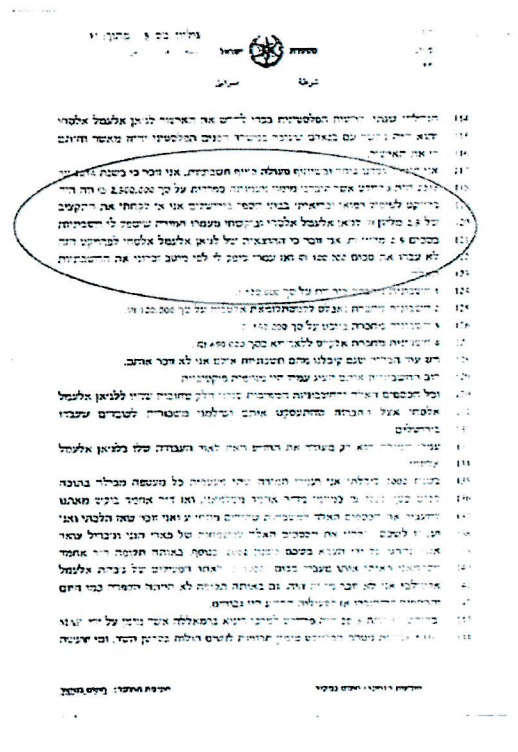

Amru and I worked together and in cooperation on the forgery of invoices, I remember that from 2014 to 2016 there was a project for which we received funding from a Spanish association in the amount of 2,500,000 NIS, and this was a project for medical and health care at schools in Jerusalem, I grabbed the budget of 2.5 million NIS for the HWC and requested from Amru Hamudeh to provide an invoice of 2.5 million NIS. I remember that the HWC's expenses for this project didn't exceed the amount of 100,000 NIS, and then Amru supplied me, to the best of my recollection, these invoices..."

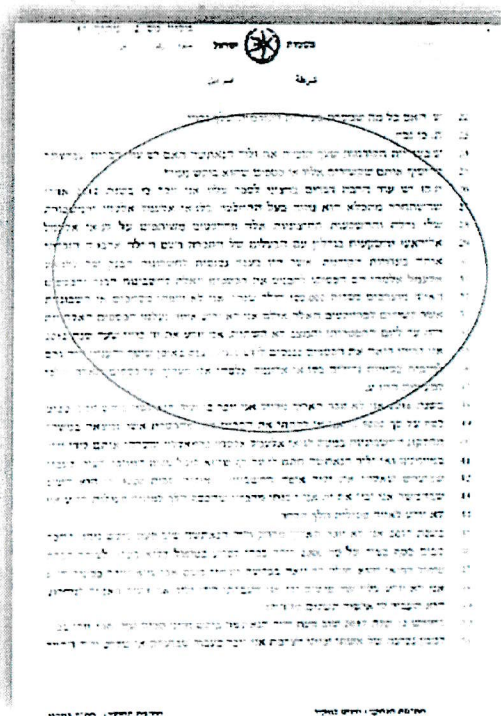

Investigation finding: The HWC diverted funds by avoiding from deposit them at the bank



From Said Abedat's police protocol, 11.4.21, lines 24 – 37

"In 2012... They stopped putting these funds into the bank accounts, and this money is estimated to be in the amount of 100,000 dollars annually... I don't know where this money disappeared... I estimate that this money went to PFLP activities..."

***Comment:** In his police protocol, Abedat refers to the activity of the HWC manager, Walid Hanatshe – a PFLP member who was arrested for his part in the terrorist attack at Ein Bubin in Aug' 2019, in which a young Israeli woman was murdered. Hanatshe provided the funding for the PFLP militants who committed the terror attack.

"... The vaccines that the HWC supplied to students, and the HWC's vaccines were received for free from the Palestinian Authority. After about a year, the HWC presented to the Spanish donor forged documents in which it was noted that we purchased the vaccines from the Palestinian Authority, and we received funds for the vaccines in high amounts..."



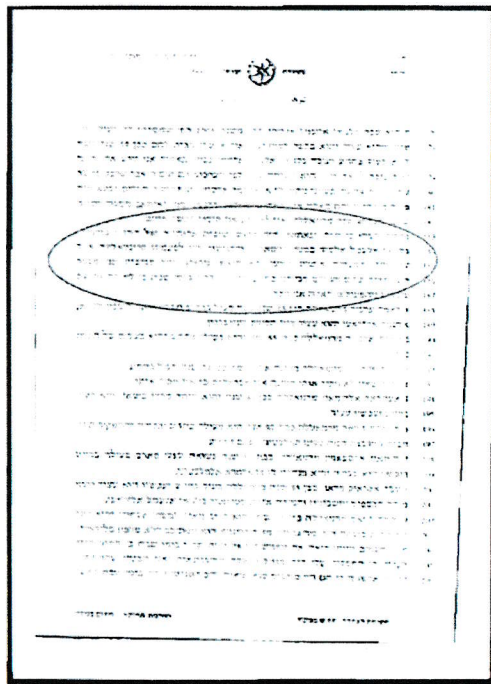
Investigation finding: The Health Work Committee issued fictitious documentation of acquisitions

From Said Abedat's police protocol, 2.4.21, lines 154 – 160

"... Pages 60-62 – there is an invoice from the Al-Quds L'Imostahadarat Al-Tabi (a Jerusalem company for medical products) in the amount of 68,459 NIS and a check from 18.12.2017 in the amount of 70,000 NIS, and also a page from the bank account of Palestinian investments it appears that 70,000 NIS were transferred to the company mentioned above. From these pages, it is correct that the money was paid to the company... however, nothing was purchased and this is a forged invoice, was paid in order to reduce an old debt of the HWC, and in order to earn the amount of money in the project..."



Investigation finding: The HWC's offices were used for PFLP activities



From Said Abidat's police protocol, 7.4.21, lines
183 – 186

"... I want to comment that Walid Hanatshe carried out PFLP organizational meetings in his office in the HWC at the headquarters in Ramallah, and the meetings were frontal one-on-one, and sometimes people came without coordinating in advance. And there are meetings with a number of participants, among them are senior PFLP operatives..."



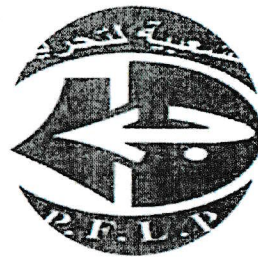

Comment: This was a terrorist attack carried out in 2019 at Ein Bubin that caused the death of Rina Shnerb RIP. The attack was carried out by PFLP operatives, some of them employees of the PFLP's network of institutions.

The diversion of European funds to the PFLP could be facilitated in the absence of effective inspection over the funding process.

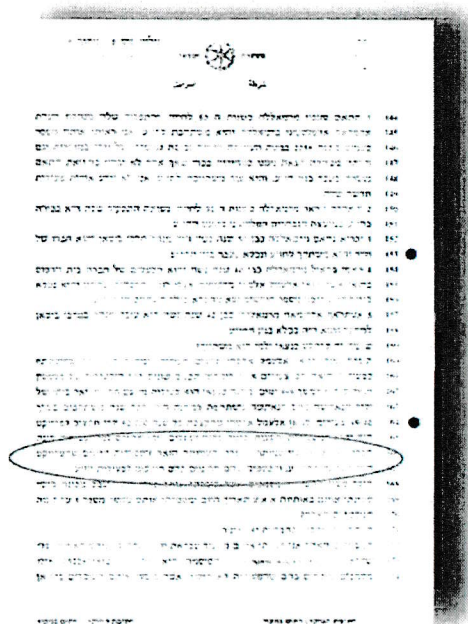

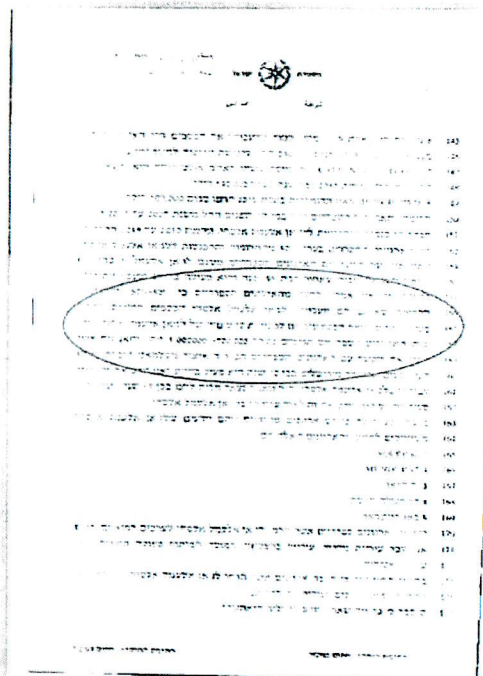

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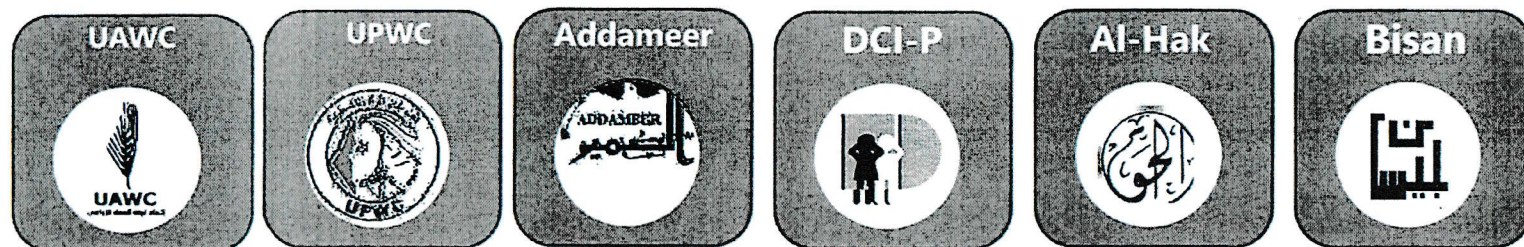
